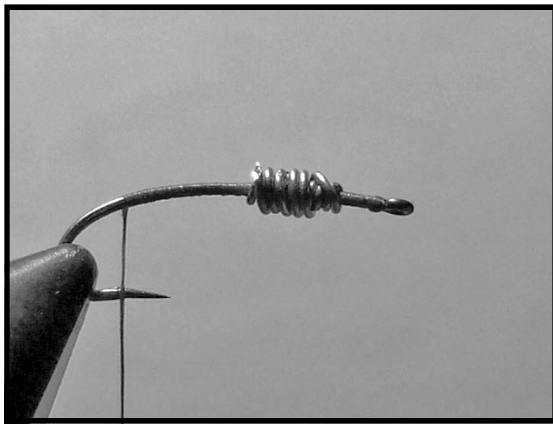


Gold Ribbed Hare's Ear Nymph

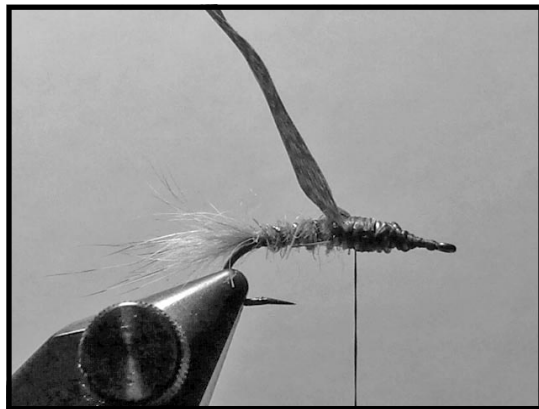
Hook:	TMC 200 or equivalent size 8-20
Thread	Brown 6/0
Lead	.020 lead wire
Tail	Long hairs from Hare's mask
Rib	Medium gold french tinsel
Body	Hare's Ear dubbing, natural color
Wingcase	Pheasant tail fibers
Thorax	Hare's Ear



Step 1: Apply a double layer of lead, about 6 turns each layer, to the shank, 1/3 of the way to the bend. Start the thread and overwrap the lead to hold in place, then wrap to bend of hook just above the barb.



Step 2: Tie in some long face hairs from a Hare's mask for a tail. Tie in the Tinsel just in front of the tail. Dub the thread with Hare's mask and wrap forward to just behind the lead.



Step 3: Tie in the Pheasant tail fibers for the wing case as shown. Then dub the thread with more Hare's Ear and form the Thorax.



Step 4: Bring the wing case forward over the top of the thorax and tie off. Whip finish and cement. Then pick out the Hare's ear fibers of the thorax to form legs on bottom side of thorax.
